

CUSTOM MOLDED WIRELESS INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING!

The molding process involves heating your molds and forming them to your ears. **DO NOT PLACE THE HOT MOLD INTO YOUR EAR.** Wait until the mold is warm and pliable.

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Decibullz Wireless
- Boiling water
- Glass or ceramic cup
- Metal pan (stovetop)
- Silicone Tips
- Metal spoon
- Timer
- Mirror (optional)

The molding process is time sensitive. Read through these instructions before starting.


Clean ears thoroughly. Pull back hair and remove any jewelry that may interfere with the molding process.

Heat

①

Attach correct size silicone tips to mold. (fig. 1)


You can change the tips after the molding process is complete.


Boil water, remove from heat. (fig. 2)

If using the microwave use a glass or ceramic cup. Do NOT place the mold in the microwave with the water.

Place ONE mold in the hot water. Multiple molds WILL stick together if heated at the same time. Let sit for 5 minutes. (fig. 3)



Remove mold with metal spoon and let cool for 30 seconds. (fig. 4)

CAUTION: ITEMS MAY BE VERY HOT.

Be sure to use a metal spoon, the mold may stick to plastic.



Shape

Plug earphone into back of mold. (fig. 5)

Insert mold and earphone into ear. (fig. 6)

⑥

Gently press mold to fill concha (bowl) of ear. (fig. 7)

CAUTION: DO NOT PLACE THE MOLD INTO EAR WHILE IT IS HOT. WAIT UNTIL THE MOLD IS WARM AND PLIABLE.

Tips: Use a mirror to help. To ensure a smooth looking mold avoid using your fingernails, also avoid "overmolding," gently push in with the pad of your finger.




Let cool for 5 minutes, repeat with the other mold and ear. (fig. 8)

Remolding

To re-fit, remove the mold from the earphone. Place the mold back in boiling water for 1-2 minutes then repeat the shape process.




WARNING!

Excessive heat can deform the molds. Be careful not to leave earphones in the car or any other place that could expose them to excessive heat. Molds **MAY** melt and can adhere to upholstery.

Charging your Headset

1. Prior to using your headset for the first time, or after no use for an extended time, fully charge the battery.
2. Approx. 1 hour is required to fully charge the battery.
3. The indicator light turns red while charging and will automatically turn blue when fully charged.
4. When battery is low the indicator light will flash red. (Headset will turn off automatically when the battery is fully drained.)
5. Headset can be used while charging.



Pairing your Headset

1. Ensure the headset is off and less than 1 meter from your bluetooth device.
2. Press and hold Multi-Function Button (MFB, middle button) until indicator light alternately flashes red and blue and you hear "pairing."
3. On your device search bluetooth devices.
4. Select headset "BULLZ01" from the devices list.
5. If your device has bluetooth 2.0 or lower enter the pairing code "0000" and confirm. You should hear "paired" and then "your phone is connected."
6. If pairing cannot be completed within 5 minutes of entering PAIRING MODE the headset will automatically enter STANDBY MODE. Repeat from step one to attempt again.
7. Ensure that there are no obstructions between your headset and device and that they are within range.

Turning on Headset

In OFF MODE press and hold the MFB for 2 seconds until you hear "power on." The indicator light will turn blue. If you have previously paired the headset it will automatically connect with that device.

Turning off Headset

In ON MODE press and hold the MFB for 3 seconds until you hear "power off." The indicator light will turn red for 1 second. Note: if the headset isn't connected to any devices within 20 minutes it will automatically turn off.

Answering/Ending Calls

Press MFB once.

Mute

During a call press and hold "V+" for 3 seconds to enter MUTE MODE. While in MUTE the speaker will beep twice every 10 seconds. To exit MUTE MODE press and hold "V+" for 3 seconds again.

Adjusting Volume

Quickly press "V+" or "V-" to adjust the volume. When the speaker has reached max or min volume you will hear a beep.

Skipping Tracks

Press and hold either "V+" or "V-" for 2 seconds to skip to the next or back to previous respectively.

Pause/Play

Quickly press the MFB to pause your music and again to play.

Voice Control

To access voice control quick press "V+" and "V-" at the same time.

Delete Pairing List/Reset Headset

While headset is on and not connected press and hold "V+" and "V-" at the same time until red and blue light flash twice. You will hear a beep. Then press MFB for 3 seconds. This will delete the pairing record and the headset. After the record has been deleted and the headset it turned back on it should enter PAIRING MODE automatically.

Indicator Light

Status	Headset Performance
Pairing Mode	Headset can be paired, indicator light alternates blue and red.
Not Connected	Headset is not connected with the device. Blue light flashes once every 2 seconds.
Standby Mode	Headset is connected with device, but not operating. Blue light flashes once every 5 seconds.
Active State	Headset is being used on a call or for music. Blue light flashes once every 10 seconds.
Charging Mode	Headset is plugged in. Red light is on continuously until fully charged, then changes to blue.
Low Battery	When the battery is low the light flashes red.

Pairing with Multiple Devices

1. Turn off bluetooth on the device to which the headset is connected.
2. With the headset off, press and hold the MFB until headset enters pairing mode.
3. On your second device search bluetooth devices.
4. Select headset "BULLZ01" from the devices list.
5. If your device has bluetooth 2.0 or lower enter the pairing code "0000" and confirm. You should hear "paired" and then "your phone is connected."
6. To switch back to the first device, follow steps 1 and 2 again.*

*Depending on your device, you may have to go into bluetooth settings and "connect" the headset again.

WARNINGS AND SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Your Decibullz have an acoustic seal, listening levels will be perceived as louder. Insert your Decibullz and the volume low and increase as needed.
- The acoustic seal created by Decibullz will block out external noise. Use of Decibullz while operating a vehicle, bicycling, or jogging may be dangerous.
- Do not tamper with your Decibullz product.
- Exposing Decibullz to temperatures above 150° F will cause them to melt.
- Do not leave Decibullz in direct sunlight for an extended period of time.
